

EU Taxonomy Analyst – Senior Manager

Reporting to the PSO Subvention & Reporting Controller this is a new senior finance role which will be core to Bus Éireann building expertise in this rapidly evolving area. The successful candidate will assist in guiding and driving the development of EU Taxonomy and CSRD reporting within Bus Éireann, the integration with financial reporting as well as ensuring data transparency and reliability and will lead and be focused on related reporting and regulatory.

BÉ aims to become the centre of excellence in relation to EU Taxonomy. Working with both internal stakeholders and external subject matter experts the successful candidate will be focused on the following for EU Taxonomy;

- Eligibility Evaluation and KPIs
- Alignment Evaluation
- Develop internal processes, control systems and structures for Taxonomy reporting across the organisation in close alignment with operational, sustainability and finance functions
- Reporting disclosures & automation preparation –automation roadmap for data collection and reporting
- Implementation plan for limited and future reasonable assurance requirements on EU Taxonomy reporting
- Lead on enabling BÉ to be EU Taxonomy self-sufficient for financial reporting year 2023 and beyond
- Provide guidance and training to BÉ finance staff on EU Taxonomy reporting requirements
- Lead the integration of EU Taxonomy into annual report
- Liaise with our auditors and other key stakeholders to ensure unqualified and timely assurance of our taxonomy data
- Guide the future direction of sustainability reporting for BÉ by following developments in ESG reporting such as EU Taxonomy and the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)

As well as the above the successful candidate will support the PSO Subvention & Reporting Controller and the CFO in ensuring that BÉ is sufficiently funded to meet all future sustainability goals.

- Qualified accountant with at least 3 years' PQE with strong Taxonomy / Sustainability reporting experience
- Interest and knowledge of sustainability matters and demonstrates an understanding of the sustainability reporting landscape and latest developments.
